QUESTION 1

Your company uses Office Communications Server 2007 Standard Edition. You have a Front-End server and an Access Edge server. Employees currently use Office Communications Server 2007 to communicate over the internal network. You need to enable communications between the internal network and the public instant messaging networks. What should you do?

Your company uses Office Communications Server 2007. You are configuring a Windows Server 2008 computer named Web1 for Communicator Web Access. You need to ensure that Web1 supports the use of nonWindows-based browsers and operating systems. What should you do?

- B. Create a new virtual server that has the Forms-based password authentication setting enabled.
- C. Create a new virtual server that has the Integrated (NTLM/Kerberos) password authentication setting enabled.

QUESTION 3

Child domain	corp.contoso.com	Windows Server 2003	Windows Server 2008 x64 Edition

You are deploying Office Communications Server 2007 in the corp.contoso.com domain. You need to store global settings for Office Communications Server 2007 in the Configuration container.

Which two actions should you perform? (Each correct answer presents part of the solution. Choose two.)

- B. Raise the forest functional level to Windows Server 2008.

QUESTION 4

The London office has only Windows Server 2003 Enterprise Edition domain controllers. The Madrid office has only Windows 2000 Server domain controllers. The domain functional level is set to Windows 2000 mixed. You need to prepare your environment for Office Communications Server 2007. What should you do first?

CORP1 is trusted by all the companys servers. CORP2 has its certificate chain installed on all company portable computers.

You install a new Office Communications Server 2007 Access Edge server. The wizard prompts you for an online CA for the certificate.

You need to supply a name that assigns a certificate to the internal interface on the Access Edge server and ensures connection to the correct CA.

You are preparing the environment to migrate to Office Communications Server 2007 R2. You back up the configuration.

You attempt to run the Office Communications Server 2007 R2 Setup Wizard on Server1. The wizard fails. You need to upgrade Server1 and Server2 to Office Communications Server 2007 R2.

What should you do first?

You are installing a new Front-End server and a new Mediation server for the London office. You configure Pool3 to use the telephone system in the Los Angeles office for testing before deploying the servers in the London office.

Each office must use its own telephone system for placing outside telephone calls. After you complete testing, you need to configure Office Communications Server 2007 to route calls for the London office.
